



10-Year Limited Warranty: Installation within 1 Mile of Salt Water (Galvanized and Powder Coated Components)

Fortress Evolution Framing warrants its products and accessories to be free from manufacturing defects in materials and workmanship. Furthermore, this limited warranty maintains that this product will retain its structural integrity. The term of this limited warranty is 10 years from the date of purchase to the original purchaser.

This warranty does not cover damages caused by: abnormal or improper use, improper product application, shipping damage, accident, alteration, welding, neglect, abuse, vandalism, lawn care equipment damage, abrasion, harsh chemicals, pool water, pool chemicals, chemicals for ice removal, air pollutants, damage caused by flood, fire, or acts of God. Surface fading and surface corrosion from scratches, nicks, and dents are not covered.

This warranty covers Evolution Framing product installed within 1 mile of salt water. The stipulation being that the product is inspected, and any corrosion or damage is treated per the guidelines below under the Maintenance Requirements. Building near salt water will cause steel framing members to corrode. It's not a question of if, but when. This warranty is void if the Maintenance Requirements are not followed. The non-powder coated 18-Gauge joist is NOT covered under this warranty.

Fortress Evolution Framing does not warrant against, nor is responsible for any defects caused by improper installation, not properly following the maintenance requirements, exceeding design limitations, and/or movement caused by ground settling. This warranty is also void if product is not installed in accordance with local laws and building codes.

Rust or corrosion on any surface on or around the frame installation, caused from steel shavings and/or chips left-over from the steel cutting process, is NOT covered by this warranty.

Maintenance Requirements for Galvanized and Powder Coated Evolution Steel Deck Framing Products and Surfaces:

- As product is installed, all cut ends must be cleaned with a file to remove all burrs and completely covered with a minimum of (3) three coats of Fortress Black Sand Touch-Up Paint.
- As the product is installed, remove all debris from inside the parts by holding them vertical and bumping one end against a solid surface. Not removing the debris may cause staining to surrounding surfaces.
- All nicks, scratches, dents, etc. that expose the steel must be completely covered with a minimum of (3) three coats of Fortress Black Sand Touch-Up Paint or Fortress Paint Pen.
- If rust occurs on the surface, it must be cleaned and painted. To clean the rusted area, sand the affected surface with 400 grit sandpaper and apply (3) three coats of Fortress Black Sand Touch-up Paint.
- Twice a calendar year, the entire deck frame must be inspected for corrosion. Contact Fortress at
 warranties@fortressframing.com or reference the Evolution Installation Guide for the inspection form. <u>THE</u>
 INSPECTION FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED WITHIN (2) WEEKS AFTER THE INSPECTION IS COMPLETE by emailing it
 to warranties@fortressframing.com. Not submitting the form to Fortress will void the warranty.
- During installation and any subsequent alterations, all steel shavings and/or chips resulting from the cutting
 process must be removed from the job site. Not removing steel shavings and/or chips could result in the staining
 of surrounding surfaces.
- Ensure all construction materials such as concrete, plaster, and paint splashes are removed immediately before they have a chance to dry. Failure to remove these materials may cause damage to the galvanized and powder-coated surfaces.





• Do not use strong solvents such as thinners, or solutions containing chlorinated hydrocarbons, esters, or ketones. Abrasive cleaners or cutting compounds cannot be used.

THE AMOUNT OF YOUR RESTITUTION WILL NOT INCLUDE LABOR TO REMOVE EXISTING COMPONENTS OR INSTALL THE REPLACEMENT COMPONENTS, SHIPPING CHARGES, SALES TAX, OR ANY OTHER CHARGES, NOR IS FORTRESS FRAMING REQUIRED TO PROVIDE SUCH LABOR OR SERVICE.

The proration schedule below applies to all Galvanized and Powder Coated Evolution Steel Deck Framing products:

(1-5) Years 100% Replacement

(6-10) Years 70% Replacement
